



DESIGNING ORGANIZATIONAL AND PEDAGOGICAL CONDITIONS FOR INCREASING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF STUDENT MANAGEMENT

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Abstract. *This thesis scientifically examines the methodological and pedagogical foundations for designing organizational and pedagogical conditions to enhance the effectiveness of student management in higher education institutions. Student management is analyzed as a multi-component pedagogical system, and methods for designing organizational and pedagogical conditions that ensure effective management are discussed. The article identifies the main organizational and pedagogical factors aimed at improving management effectiveness and develops priority directions and methodological recommendations for their implementation.*

Keywords: *student management, management effectiveness, organizational and pedagogical conditions, design, pedagogical management.*

The process of student management in higher education institutions is an important factor not only in improving the quality of education, but also in ensuring the personal, academic, and social development of students¹. The student management system is interpreted as a complex pedagogical process that includes educational, upbringing, organizational, and social components and is aimed at ensuring their integration. Therefore, the scientific design of organizational and pedagogical conditions to improve management effectiveness emerges as a pressing task.

Organizational and pedagogical conditions play a decisive role in developing students' academic activity, motivation, and creative potential, improving the quality of pedagogical decision-making, as well as achieving the strategic goals of higher education institutions. They ensure the principles of systematicity and continuity in the management process, increase the effectiveness of the educational process, and strengthen cooperation between administration and teaching staff.

Modern pedagogical theories and management approaches show that the student management process should not be limited solely to control and administrative management. On the contrary, it should be based on systematic and integrated mechanisms that encourage students' active participation and serve to substantiate pedagogical decision-making². From

The main objective of this thesis is to identify the principles for scientifically designing organizational and pedagogical conditions to enhance the effectiveness of student management in higher education institutions and to develop effective directions for their implementation in practice. At the same time, the article analyzes organizational and pedagogical factors that ensure management effectiveness and develops methodological recommendations for their design.

Improving the effectiveness of student management is closely linked to ensuring the continuity of educational quality in higher education institutions and supporting students' personal development. An effective management system ensures the systematic and coherent nature of the management process, as well as the alignment of educational, upbringing, organizational, and social components. The use of electronic platforms and information systems accelerates the management process, strengthens monitoring and control, and also expands opportunities for students' self-assessment and for substantiating pedagogical decisions. In addition, strengthening cooperation between teachers and the administration is an important factor in improving management effectiveness. Collaborative decision-making in pedagogy and the harmonization of organizational processes ensure the systematic and coherent nature of the
