The atmosphere of friendship and mutual understanding in the new Uzbekistan will ensure peace and stability in our country, increase the effectiveness of strategic reforms, and further enhance its prestige in the international arena. The results of these reforms are fully reflected in the reforms being carried out by our leader today[5]. In particular, Goal 74 of the development strategy is dedicated to strengthening the atmosphere of interethnic harmony and interreligious tolerance in society, and it sets out the following tasks:

- further improve the system of state support for national cultural centers.

- The new Uzbekistan Development Strategy also pays special attention to the development of applied and fine arts and design, and to improving the artistic and aesthetic taste of the population, and the following tasks have been identified:
- To widely disseminate the exemplary life and work of Uzbek people's artists and masters of applied arts in order to perpetuate the memory of them.

- Improvement of the system of training qualified personnel in fine and applied arts and design.

- 1. Strengthen the material and technical base of 25 folklore ensembles under national cultural centers, provide them with stage costumes, musical instruments, modern sound and lighting equipment, and buses.
- 2. Create conditions for free use of cultural centers for folklore groups to hold rehearsals and concerts.
- 3. Organize, overhaul and modernize the "Friendship" concert hall on the basis of the large hall of the Committee for Interethnic Relations and Friendship with Foreign Countries;

**Fourth,** in order to hold international cultural events aimed at the wide dissemination of our national culture and art, the following tasks have been identified:

- 1. Organizing and holding the III International Bakhshi Art Festival in the city of Gulistan.
  - 2. Organizing and holding the XIII International Music Festival "Oriental Songs".
  - 3. Organization and holding of the II International Maqom Art Conference in Bukhara.
- 4. Organization and holding of the "Bahor Nafasi" International Festival in Tashkent region.
- 5. Organization and holding of the "Dunyo Sadolari" International Festival in Andijan region.
- 6. Organization and holding of the International Chamber and Symphonic Music Festival in Tashkent;
